

How to Watch Monday Night Football if You Use YouTube TV (Madison Area)

TL;DR: YouTube TV lost **ABC** and **ESPN** during a Disney dispute. That's why MNF isn't showing up. Quick fixes for tonight: **1)** subscribe to the **ESPN** app (fastest single-channel option), **2)** switch to **CUE** (lists ABC & ESPN), or **3)** use an **indoor antenna** for ABC. Some YouTube TV users can claim a **\$20 credit** during the blackout.

Watch MNF Tonight: 3 Fast Options

1. **ESPN App** — Sign up, install, tap *Live*, press play. (Standalone starts at **\$29.99/mo.**)
2. **CUE** — Simple bundle replacement. CUE's public lineup includes **ABC** and **ESPN**; verify your local during signup. [Start CUE.](#)
3. **Antenna** — If you just need the ABC simulcast, plug in an indoor antenna and scan channels.

Why This Is Happening

More than 20 Disney-owned channels—including **ABC** and **ESPN**—were removed from YouTube TV after the contract expired at **11:59 PM ET on Oct 30, 2025**. A new deal hasn't been announced yet.

Quick Buyer FAQ

Can I still watch MNF with YouTube TV?

Not on ABC/ESPN during the blackout. Use the ESPN app, try CUE, or use an antenna for ABC.

Is YouTube TV offering anything?

Some subscribers can claim a **\$20** bill credit during the dispute.
